The Ashland Community Resource Center (ACRC)

is launching a new program to encourage area producers to consider donating livestock, bushels of corn, soybeans, wheat, or other commodities directly to the ACRC.

Your contribution will help build a new library, senior center and meeting place for the city of Ashland and its surrounding areas. It will buy new books and computers as well as furnishings inside and a children's play area outside.

There are so many reasons to give.

- ◆ The seeds you plant in your field can help plant the seed of knowledge in the next generation.
- ◆ Your gift will ensure that all Ashland and surrounding area children have access to books and computers.
- ◆ Your help will give seniors a place to gather and grow.
- ◆ While you receive a tax benefit for your gift, you also help create a new library, senior center and meeting place for the people of our community.
- ◆ Your gift will help our community grow into the future.

Your gift will have a huge impact on our lives, our children's lives and our grandchildren's lives. The new resource center will help us move into the future with vision.

Although there are many ways to donate to the new center, donating grain to the ACRC is a win-win for everyone involved. Gifts of grain may eliminate taxes on the donation and retain 100 percent of the value for the charity.

Why give grain instead of cash?

Donated grain is not recorded as income; so you may save all or some of the following taxes:

Self-employment taxes of approximately 15%
State and county taxes of approximately 5%
(depending on tax rates)
and federal income tax

Give grain rather than cash.

If you give grain, the effective cost of your \$10,000 donation could be \$5,500

As an example: depending on tax rates, you could pay \$2,500 less in federal income taxes, \$500 less in state and local taxes and another \$1,500 in self-employment taxes. Total tax savings are \$4,500. Use that money to offset the cost of your gifts or give the savings to charity.

It's that easy. We will create an account at your chosen elevator and provide grain disposition instructions. Upon delivery of your commodity to the elevator, please request the bushels be placed into the ACRC account. Call us with any questions!
