A drop-down menu will appear. Click on “Overdrive—Audiobooks and Ebooks” to get to the Nebraska Overdrive Website.



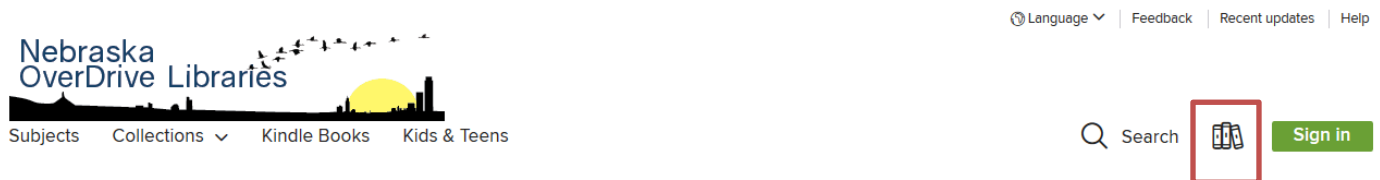

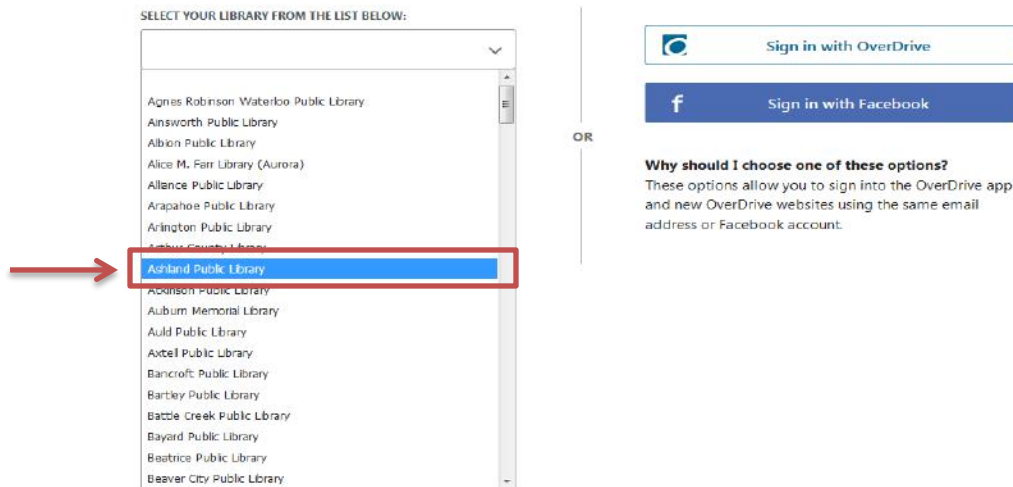
It will ask you to sign in. Click either button.

Checking Out

To check out, search for and select a title. For example: "A World Below" by Wesley King. Click the title for a summary, or just click "borrow" underneath—if you just click borrow, a "Go to Holds" button will appear under the title.





His soldiers brought the offender before him, dragging


Turn pages with a click and drag motion, or by using the left and right arrows on the right hand side of the keyboard.

On the “Loans” page there is a small icon under each material that looks like this:




Select that icon.



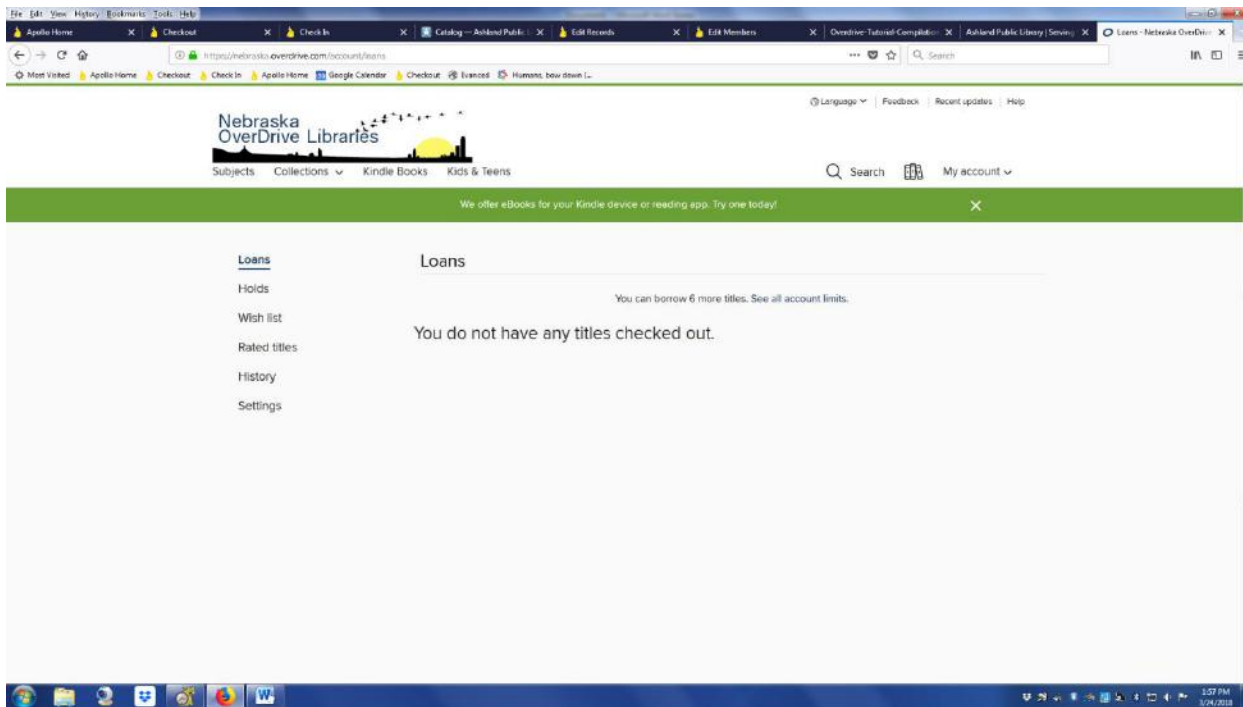

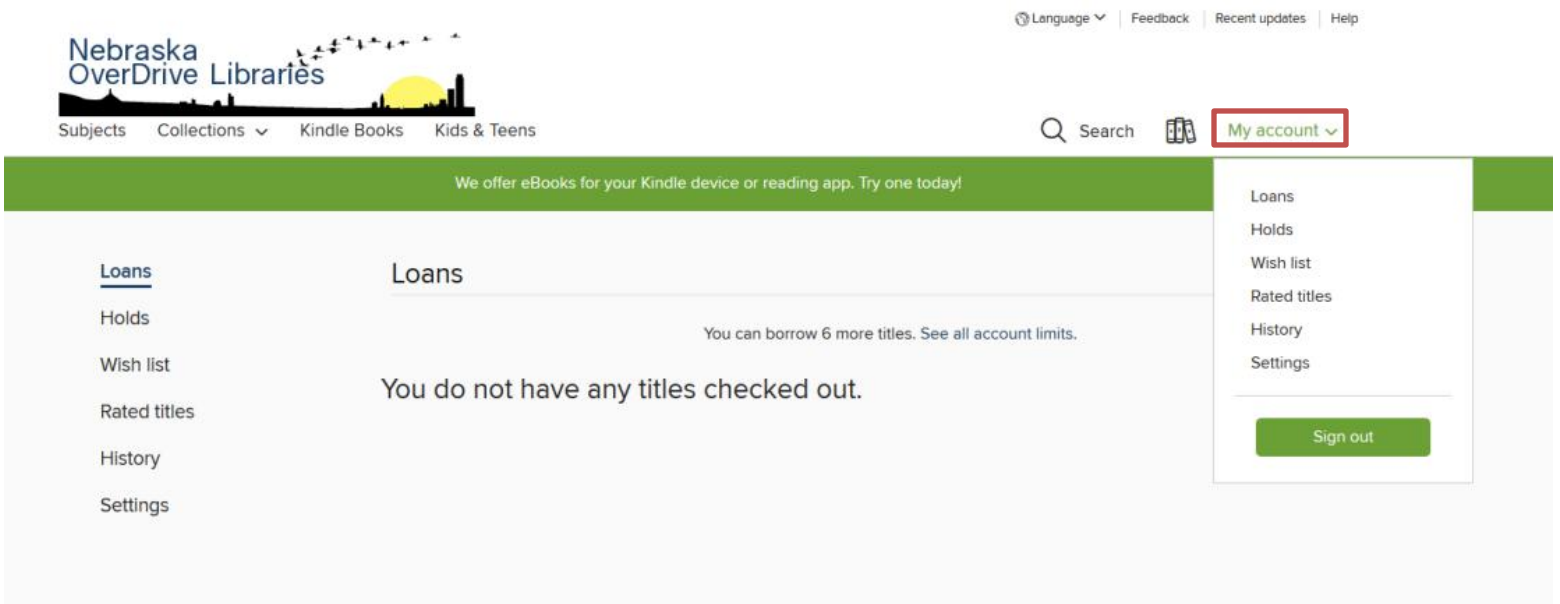

After clicking “Return Title” the “Loans” screen returns. Congratulations, you have returned the title!

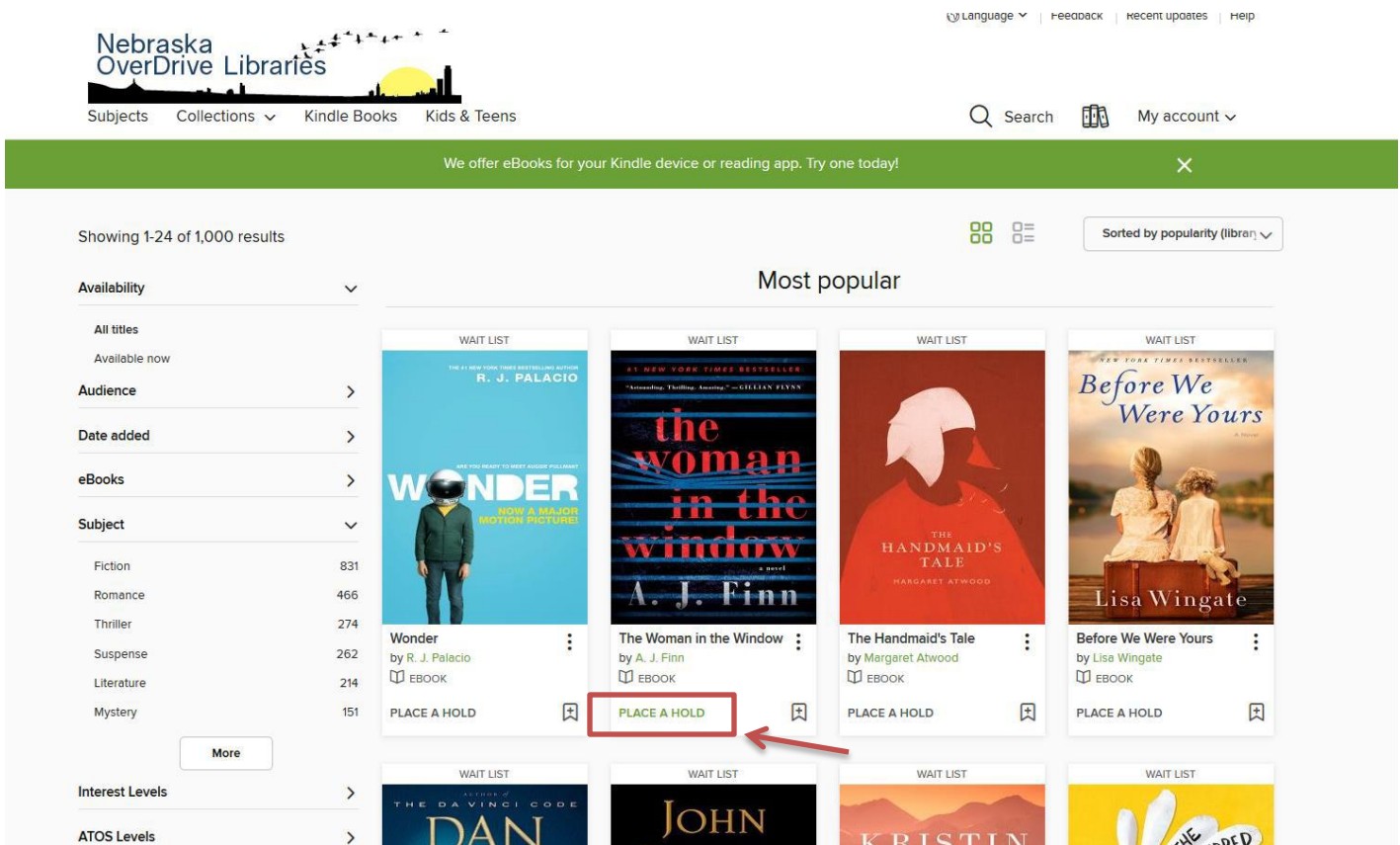


At this point, you can check out something new or sign out. To sign out, select the arrow next to “My account”. A dropdown menu will give you a number of options, including a “Sign Out” button.

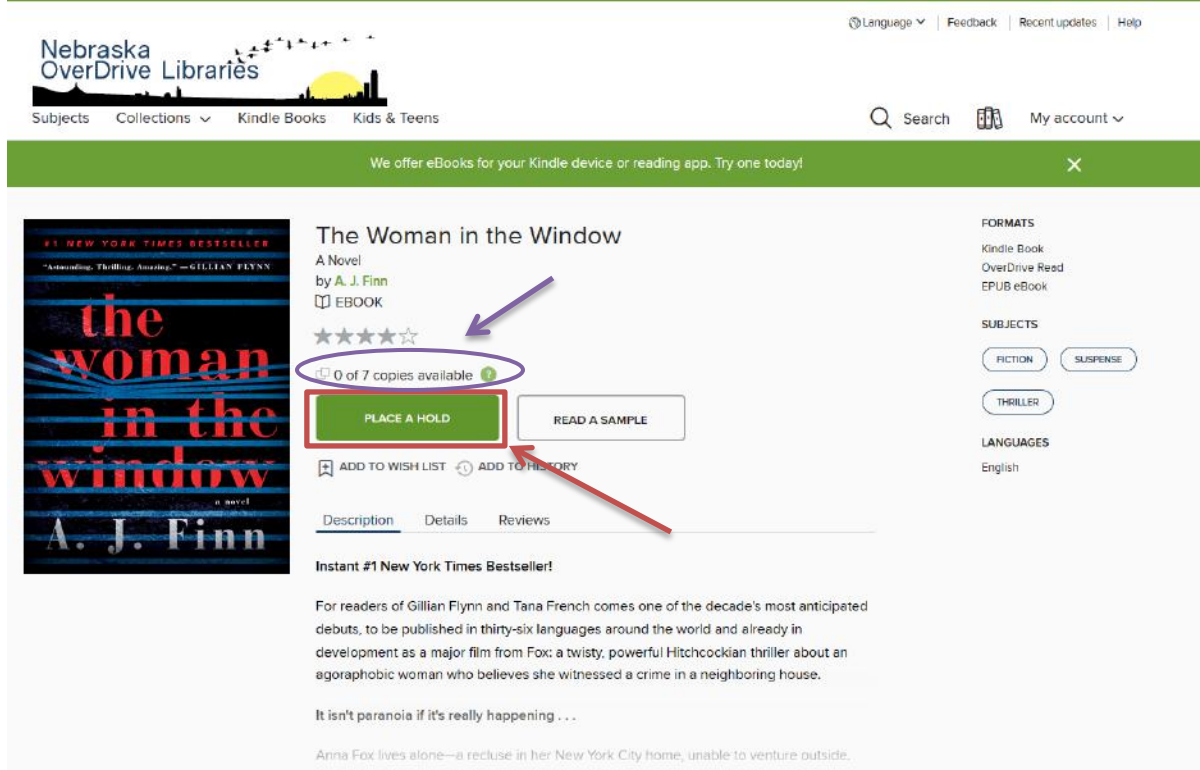


Placing a Hold in Overdrive

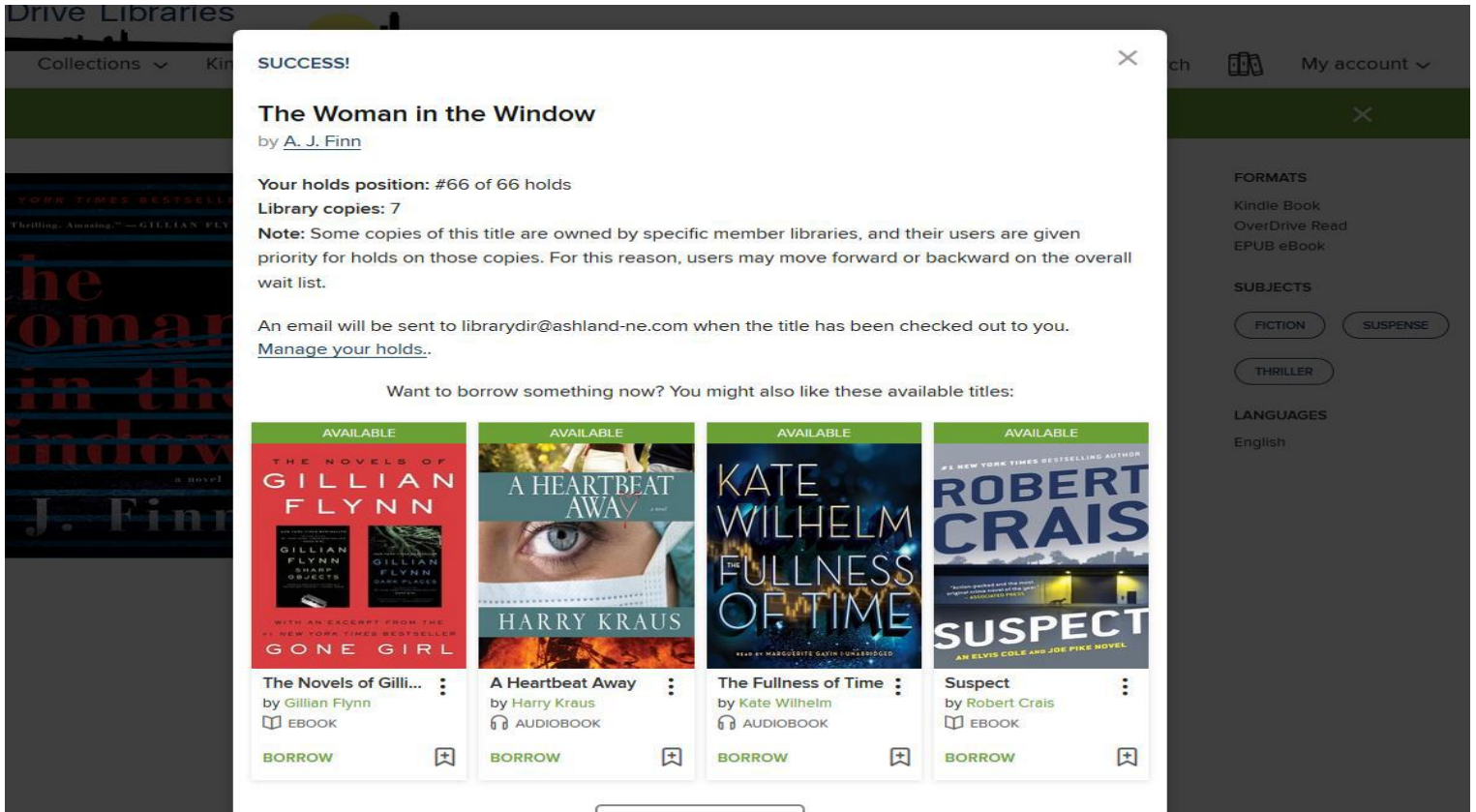
To place a hold on a title, select the title or the “Place a Hold” button underneath it.



Selecting the title will take you to a summary page. You can also click the “Place a Hold” button from here. It will tell you how many copies are available. In this case there are 0 of 7 copies.



After clicking "Place a Hold", a dialog box will pop up. It will have information about how many people are in line for the title and offer similar titles while you wait for the hold to become available. Click the "X" in the upper right to close.



After closing the dialog box, it will return to the summary page. Continue searching, or go to loans or holds by clicking the arrow next to "My account".



“Go to Holds” will take you to this page where you can see how many other people are waiting for this title. In this case, there are 65 other people waiting for the book, and only 7 copies of the book available for checkout with all titles currently checked out (that’s why we placed a hold). You will get an email when the item becomes available.



Adding to a Wish-list

On the book summary page there is a small flag icon under the “Borrow” or “Place a Hold” button. This is the “Add to Wish-list” flag. This feature makes finding books that you might like to read easier by collecting them under your account. A red flag means it is on your wish-list while a white flag means it is not. You can add or remove items by simply clicking the flag.
