In response to COVID-19 and the Directed Health Measures, the Ravenna Public Library will be taking some sensible, proactive steps in an effort to keep both our patrons and staff safe and healthy while gradually reopening the building.

Beginning June 24th, we will be offering our patrons multiple ways in which to interact with/visit the library.

- Our curbside pick-up service will continue to run. This is a no-contact service that patrons can utilize to get books and DVDs.
- The library will be open by appointment for patrons to check-out materials, use computers and to copy/fax.
- Appointments will be on a first come, first serve basis and will be limited to 20 minutes per household.
- Patrons under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent/guardian.
- No gaming or recreational computer use.
- Children's Library will only be available to check out books.
- All social distancing recommendations will be followed.
- Staff will wear mask. We request that you do to, but it is not required.
- Upon entry into the library you will be asked to use hand sanitizer.
- Restrooms and drinking fountains will be CLOSED until further notice.
- OverDrive/Libby is an online service that the library provides all year long. This is for FREE audio and eBooks. The information to use this service can be attained by calling or emailing us.

All in-person programming has been cancelled. We will still be offering our Facebook/Zoom Summer Reading Programs Tuesday and Thursdays until July 10th. We continue to strive to provide the youth of our community with fun, educational, literacy-based opportunities. The end of Summer Reading Carnival is on hold until we are able to have everyone attend in a safe manner.

The Community Room, Makerspace, Restrooms and drinking fountain will be closed to the public at this time. We will be taking special care to clean and sanitize hard surfaces, computer keyboards, and materials returned to the library.

Though our best efforts will be put forth, this process is not perfect. We ask you to please do your part. Stay home if you are sick and practice regular hand washing and good hygiene.
