Tissue Paper Painting



Materials:

- √ Tissue Paper Squares
- √ Watercolor Paper
- ✓ Spray Bottle (or Paint Brush)
- ✓ Water
- ✓ Plastic Gloves

Directions:

- Dye from the paper will stain hands and surfaces so protective care should be taken.
- Pre-wet the watercolor paper by spraying it with a spray bottle filled with water. You can also choose to use a paintbrush if you'd like.





- Apply the tissue paper squares randomly or in a planned arrangement. We recommend spraying or painting some more water over the squares to accelerate the color "bleeding".
- For best results, allow the water to dry before removing the squares.
- Once you remove the squares, the color will have transferred onto the watercolor paper, revealing the color from the squares!
