Administrative Report:

February bills of \$1,925.52 were reviewed and approved.

A balance of \$1,540.81 was reported.

Total additions to the library were 54.

Total people in the library were 424.

Total computer users were 55,

Brown Bag Book club read and reviewed *When Crickets Cry* by Charles Martin. 4 attended.

Story Hour had 11 children/3 adults.

The library was closed for one day due to bad weather.

Old Business:

Suggested renovations to the old Senior Center, which will become the library, were looked at. John Ahlers, from the Town Board, recommended that they be re-prioritized before presenting them to the Town Board, We have a beginning budget of \$20,000 to work with. It was suggested that some of the items could be completed with volunteer help.

Items included were:

<u>Bathrooms</u>—remove second toilet in women's room and the divider—new flooring ==. Men's restroom—remove the urinal and divider==new flooring. Locks on doors. <u>Kitchen</u>—remove exhaust vents from old appliances and finish the ceiling.

Change bad tiles.

Remove water fountain-DO NOT want water around books.

New flooring in main room, office, kids and computer rooms.

Light fixture installed in the entrance room.

Paint main room, office, kids and computer rooms.

New Business:

It was suggested that any Library board members who can attend the next Town Board meeting at 5:30 on March 14 do so. They will be considering the proposed changes to the old Senior Center to make it usable for the library use.
