She lived most of her life in Farnam where she was instrumental in the establishment of the Farnam Library in the early 1940's. Hulda was active in the Methodist Church, 4-H, and the community. She was of help to many. Even today in 2008, her vision of nearly seventy years ago is evident as this library is dedicated."
