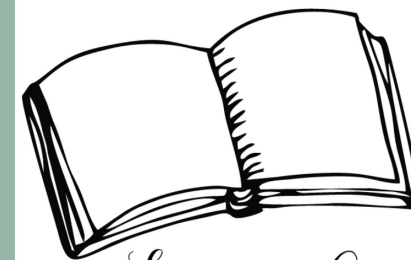
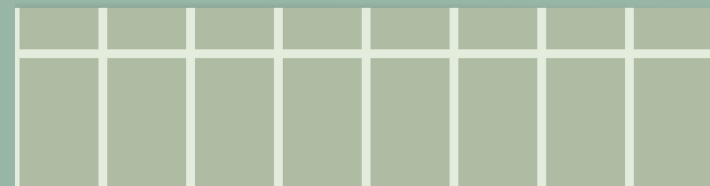

Borrowing Policies

Hastings Memorial Library cards are free of charge to residents of Perkins County. Patrons residing outside of Perkins County must pay a fee of \$5.00 per year.

A picture ID and proof of current residence are required before a card will be issued.

If your card is lost, you may obtain a replacement card for a fee of \$2.00.

Loan Periods

- 3 weeks for books and audiobooks
- 1 week for DVDs

- Items can be renewed for an additional loan period in person or by calling the library, emailing, or logging into your account online.

- Items may be returned to the library during regular business hours or by using our outside book drop anytime.

Fines

- Books & audiobooks - 10 cents/day
- DVDs - 50 cents/day

- Patrons owing fines of \$20.00 or more may lose borrowing privileges.

- Items more than 3 months overdue will be considered lost, and patrons will be billed for the replacement cost of the item.
