

# Children in the Library

- Children under 8 years of age must be accompanied by an adult 18 or older.
- VR can only be used by children ages 10 and up.
- At the discretion of staff, a parent or caregiver may be required to accompany a particular child(ren) at all times, regardless of age.
- Please be advised that like all library users, children are expected to comply with general library rules and regulations.
- Violation of “Guidelines for Patron Behavior Policy” may result in a child being asked to leave library premises.
- The library has Zero Tolerance for the following behaviors:
  - Public Displays of Affection
  - Destruction of Property
  - Theft
  - Aggressive Behavior
- Engaging in behaviors listed under the zero tolerance policy may lead to temporary to permanent suspension of library privileges, depending upon the severity of misconduct.
- The library is not responsible for a minor’s selections of library materials. The library believes it is the right of the parent and/or caregiver to determine what is appropriate for their child to meet personal family standards and guidelines.
