Ashfall Fossil Beds

Get a close-up view of the amazing fossils found at Ashfall Fossil Beds! Explore fossil discoveries and "step" into the fossil bed to get a first-hand look at some of the rhino, horse, and camel skeletons found there. Learn about the volcano in southwest Idaho that blanketed the north central area of Nebraska with glassy volcanic ash 12 million years ago, how this catastrophic event resulted in the death of much of the wildlife, and how their fossil remains were discovered and continue to be researched.

Presenters introduce the audience to live animals while giving interesting facts and information about each one while calling up volunteers to help feed a baby kangaroo, hold an alligator, and have their friends help hold a giant boa constrictor. 
