We've made so many changes over the years, I think back to what things were like when I started and it hardly seems like the same place.

This year we still have the City Offices in our old community room, so some of the things we've done in the past are out, but we're trying some new things we hope you'll like. The Breakout Sessions involve solving puzzles to open locks. The seed bombs connect to our new landscaping project, as we are working toward recognition as a pollinator habitat. With a little luck by the time Summer begins we'll have something to show you all.

Out of City Limits Kids

If you live outside of the City Limits and want to participate in the Summer Reading Program we offer a temporary free membership during the Summer break. The Summer Reader Membership lasts until September 1st after which you can choose to renew the membership at the regular rate of fifteen dollars per year..

Mind you this is fifteen dollars per YEAR. If you check out three books rather than buying them the membership will have paid for itself and, to break down the cost a bit further, fifteen dollars per year = \$1.25 per month = Less than a nickel a day. Membership also comes with access to Overdrive which can be used most anywhere that you can connect to the internet.
