Library Cards



You do not need to have a Library card to participate in programs or attend events at the Library. You need a card to check out materials from the Library.

Library cards are free for Nebraska City residents within city limits. Patrons who live outside of the Nebraska City limits can get a library card for \$20 a year in state or \$25 a year out of state that covers every member of their household. Patrons applying for a Library card must provide a photo ID.

Children can have their own Library cards. If a patron is under the age of 16, the legal guardian must sign a statement of responsibility for a Library account.

School-aged children and youth under 16 can get a provisional student card with a check out limit of two items without a legal guardian signature. The student must provide an address and telephone number for the account.

If a patron already has a Library account, the card can be renewed by updating patron account information.
