

## SEPTEMBER COMPUTER CLASSES

Classes are taught in our downstairs meeting room using our Windows 7 laptop computers. The 3-class series will cost \$10.00 per person and includes a take-home handout. Class size is limited to 10 people. Pre-registration is required. Call the library to register for classes.

<b>Computer Fundamentals</b>	<b>Thursday 9/8 at 9:30 AM</b>	This introductory class will get you familiar with computers, using the mouse and keyboard, basic terminology, shutting down your computer correctly and more.
<b>Working in Windows</b>	<b>Thursday 9/15 at 9:30 AM</b>	Learning to use the Windows operating system, understanding its basic features, opening programs, and creating a simple document with WordPad and saving it on the computer are the focus of this class.
<b>Beginning Internet</b>	<b>Thursday 9/22 at 9:30 AM</b>	Exploring the World Wide Web, basic searching and learning the features of Internet browsers will be addressed in this class.
<b>Microsoft Word 2013 Step by Step Beginning Skills 1</b>	<b>Monday 9/26 at 6:30 PM</b>	Microsoft Word is a powerful word processing program. This class will introduce word processing and its terminology. You will learn how to enter text, correct typing errors, change font, and other word processing skills.
<b>Microsoft Word 2013 Step by Step Beginning Skills 2</b>	<b>Monday 10/3 at 6:30 PM</b>	This class builds on the skills learned in Beginning Microsoft Word, giving you more hands-on practice. You will learn to use the Office Clipboard, adjust line spacing and margins, make other editing changes to documents before printing, and to print envelopes and labels.
<b>Saving and Organizing Computer Files</b>	<b>Monday 9/10 at 6:30 PM</b>	This class will teach saving files such as documents created on a computer and how to organize files in folders. Learn how to rename files, create folders, move files, and use removable media to save copies of files or folders.
