

Making Pinwheels

1. Print the templates and have the children cut them out following the outside and the dotted lines.
2. Gently bring the corners of the pinwheel in to the center. Do not fold the paper, just round it inward. Push the pin through each of the dots and then push all of them together through the center dot.
3. Push the pin all the way through a straw to attach the pinwheel.
4. Push the pin into a mini eraser. Don't make it too tight or the pinwheel will not spin.
