

Checking Out Library Materials

All borrowers must use their own SPL library card in order to check out library materials (books, magazines, audios, DVDs, outdoor game, WiFi hotspot, etc.).

New patrons are on a probationary period for 2 months. Patrons who haven't used their card in one year will again be placed on a probationary status. They may borrow a total of 3 items at any given time, and only one of these items can be a DVD. At the end of such time period and with good standing, patrons have full privileges.

With full privileges, there is a limit of 12 items (with a limit of 3 DVDs per household) which may be checked out on an adult card at one time and 8 items on a juvenile card. Twenty five items may be checked out on an out-of-county family card.

Patrons **MUST** be 17 years old (with their profile status set as adult status) to check out a DVD, outdoor game, or WiFi hotspot.

Books and periodicals may be checked out for a two-week loan period. Cake pans, newspapers, outdoor games, may be checked out for one week. Hotspots may be checked out for 2 weeks. Items may be renewed for one additional loan period by request, in person or by telephone (352-2221) during regular library hours or through the online catalog. Exceptions include items less than 3 months old and/or on a waiting list. Renewals for Hotspots must bring the device and be made in person.
