## WiFi Hotspot Use

- •Hotspots can be checked out only on adult cards (17 and older) by patrons who have a borrowing history of at least 6 months.
- •Card holder should have no unpaid fees attached to their account.
- Hotspots can be checked out for a two week period.
- •Hotspots can be renewed providing:
  - 1) There is no one on the waiting list.
- 2) Renewals are made in person and must have device with them.
- One hotspot per household at a time.
- •A late fee of \$5 a day will accrue on late hotspots.
- •Functionality of the hot spot will end on the day after it is due and it will become unusable.
- •If hotspot is not returned in good working condition, with all the included parts and cables and in the original case, patron will be charged a \$100 replacement fee.
- •Use of the hotspot is subject to the Library's Computer and Internet Use policy and Patron Privacy policy.
- •The Library will not be responsible for any files, data, or personal information accessed, transmitted, lost, or damages while accessing the internet using the hotspot.
- •Patron is responsible for the use of the internet by any minors while using the hotspot.
- •Parental supervision of children using the hotspot is advised and parents are ultimately responsible for their children's hotspot usage and activities.
- •Hotspots are filtered in compliance with the Children's Internet Protection Act (CIPA). Patrons should be aware that filtering software is not foolproof. Filters may block sites which have legitimate research value, as well as allowing some content through which parents might

find objectionable.

•In accordance with CIPA, Library staff may reset the filtering levels on the hotspot for patrons 17 and above for bona fide research, work, or other lawful usage.
