

Patron Dress Code

Because Schuyler Public Library is a public facility; for purposes of safety and hygiene and to conform to community standards, library patrons are expected to wear proper attire. Patrons must wear a covering on their upper and lower bodies (such as shirts, blouses, pants, outer shorts, skirts) and shoes. Exceptions will be made for children under the age of 3 years old in strollers, carriers, infant seats, or other carrying device.

Clothing must be zippered, buttoned, or fastened to avoid indecent exposure.

Swim suits, unless completely covered, are not considered proper attire.

Patrons will not be permitted to wear inappropriate, suggestive, vulgar, or excessively revealing clothing not conducive to community standards.

No face coverings except for medical or religious reasons.

Patrons who are wearing wet or soiled clothing that can be transferred to other patrons, library furnishings, or equipment will not be permitted in the library.

Roller skates, roller blades, or metal cleated sport shoes that can cause injury, damage the floor, or contribute to disruptive noise will also not be permitted in the library.
