To the faculty we leave our willingness to work and learn, our studious ways and sweet breath of youth.


To the freshmen we leave our luck in everything. You guys have a long way to go yet!

To the sophomores - - - Actually you kids really don't need anything.


To the juniors we leave these, our most precious possessions:
