Dedication



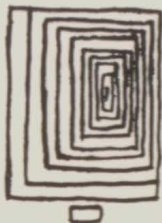
We, the Annual Staff of 1966-67, are proud to dedicate this annual to the memory of Mr. Edward Negley

To the Faculty, we will our enthusiastic attitude toward learning . . . (WHAT?)

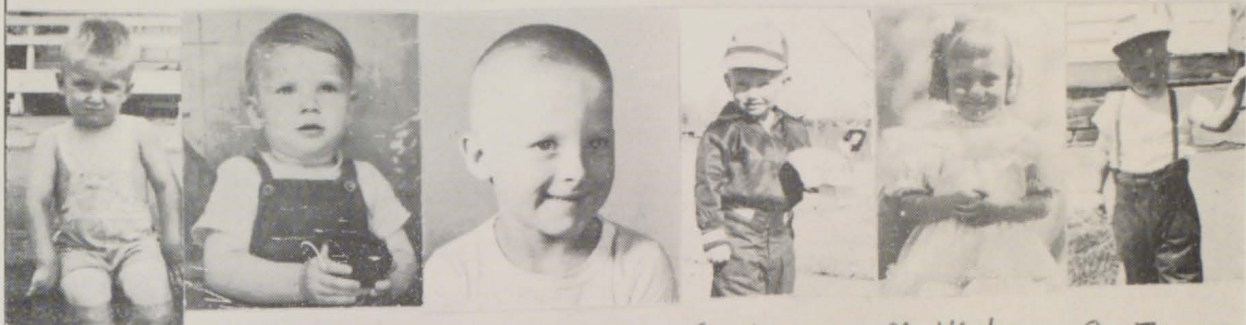

Junior-Senior Banquet and Prom, 1967

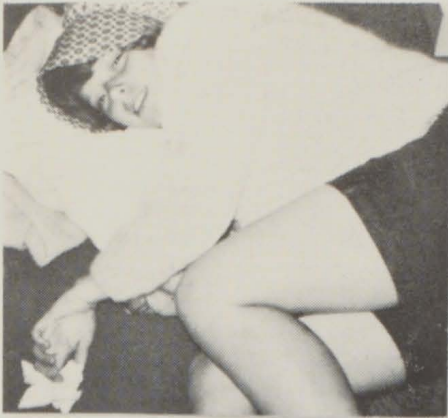
The high school gymnasium was the setting for the 1967 NLS Junior-Senior Prom and Banquet. This traditional event was held May 13.

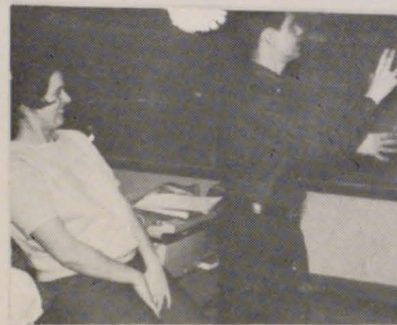
