Inter-High Team Maintains Second Place Standing

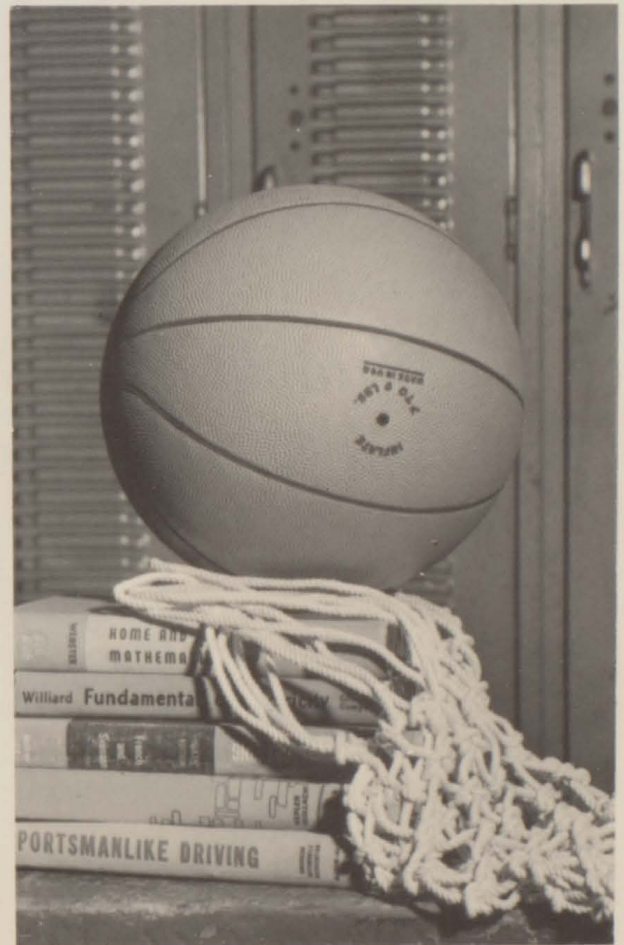
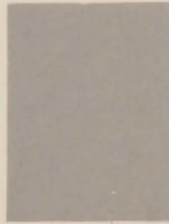
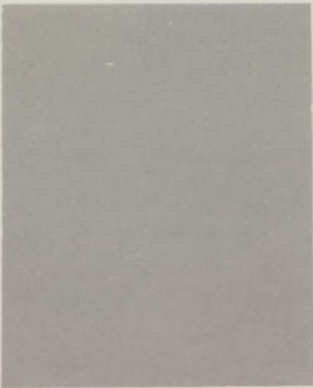
