The North Loup-Scotia Wildcats won their second consecutive football conference championship. The Wildcats finished 8-0 in conference play and 8-1 in the regular season. The Wildcats qualified for the state playoffs for the seventh time in ten years. The Cats defeated Culburtson 40-14, on a cold windy day, to capture the first playoff win in the school's history. Josh Jess and Bryan DeRiso led the Cats to the victory. Leyton dashed the hopes of the Wildcats in the quarter finals. Chad Shoemaker was All-State at Inside Linebacker. The Wildcats finished with a record of 9-2 and finished ranked number six in class-D1.

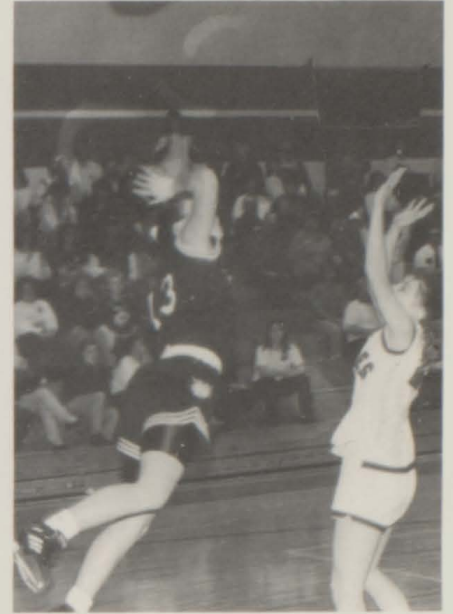
