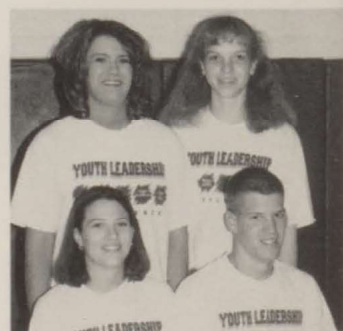

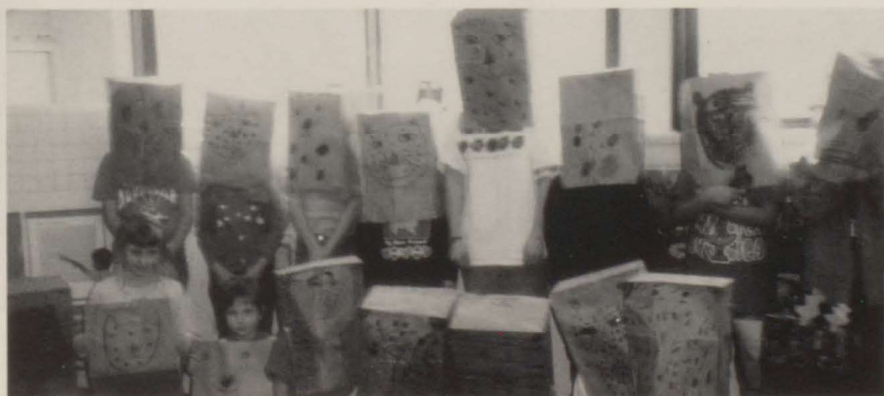

SEA members had another busy year. One of the activities they plan is the annual Elementary Day where members create and present a lesson in each elementary classroom.

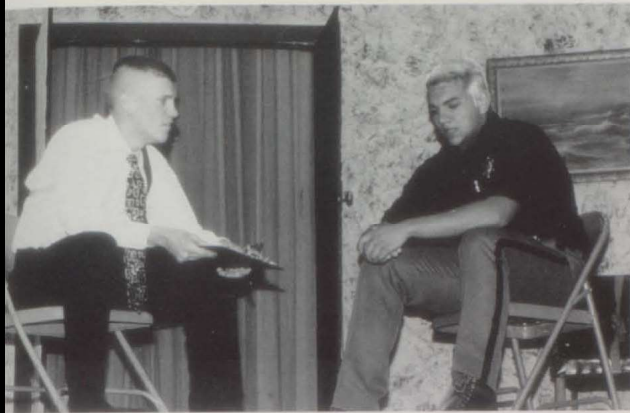

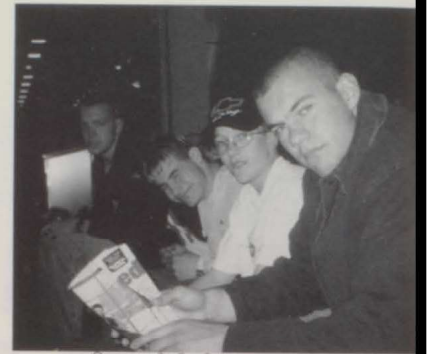
