STRATEGY/ACCESS

Free WIFI access is available at three local businesses: Pinnacle Bank, Cubby's Community Store and Shelby Community Library, utilizing personal devices. The library is the only location to offer **secured** WIFI access along with laptops and kiosk computer for public use. Library staff can also offer assistance with computer use and internet access. The focus will be to maintain fast, reliable internet access with an adequate number of laptops available for public use. New tablets will be considered as part of any future replacement of laptops.

The library has two desktop computers for staff use and shares the cost of a third desktop computer with the school. The staff uses the Internet to do research for our patrons, to place book and material orders, to correspond with other libraries and organizations, to take on-line courses and keep up with current library issues. A website is maintained for the library, with links to the libraries Facebook and Twitter pages. Nebraska Overdrive was added in 2011 to allow customers to download e-books. A link to the Polk County Newspaper Digitization was added to our website in 2017. Also a Kiosk computer was added that patrons can use to view our library website, search for library materials, search the internet, etc. The annual budget takes care of paying the \$500 for the annual fee for the Nebraska Overdrive.

The library has a single telephone line, which is used to perform essential business dealings on a daily basis, including requesting materials through Interlibrary Loan and sending or receiving faxes. The telephone also benefits patrons, in that they may call the library to request or renew materials, ask reference questions, use the fax machine to send or receive faxes and use the telephone to make local calls, if necessary. It is used as a communication link to the library for patron requests and inquiries, and also for safety purpose. The goal for telephone service is to continue to provide library staff and patrons with quality lines of communication.

GOALS

We are currently looking into upgrading the checkout desk computer. Also, we are researching a faster internet. The Shelby Library Foundation has sufficient funds to replace old computers, printers and software to keep up with technology.

The laptops received from a grant from the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation as part of the Broadband Technology Opportunities Program (BTOP) in 2011 are functioning adequately for public needs. Two of the original six were replaced in 2018, with Windows 10 laptops. As the need arises to replace these, it appears that three laptops may adequately meet public needs. In addition, the school maintains one Apple computer for students to use for the online catalog.

CONTINUING EDUCATION OPPORTUNITIES

Staff takes advantage of many continuing education classes and workshops offered by the Nebraska Library Commission, such as webinars, basic skills courses, etc. These are available on-line or workshops are attended if they are held within a reasonable traveling distance, to places such as Lincoln, Columbus and Norfolk. The Library also offers computer classes to the public, as requested by patrons. Staff can educate themselves in technology-related areas, such as by reading library publications or by visiting such places online as the Nebraska Library Commission's or the American Library Association's websites. Some technology resources that are available include websites, or any of the other many computer/technology books that the library owns. Money is included in the annual budget for continuing education and mileage.

BUDGET

Historically, E-rate has covered 60-70% of internet services. The library budgets for the remaining cost. The library budget also includes funds for computer repair, supplies and technical support. The Shelby Library Foundation also maintains a sufficient balance to assist with extraordinary expenses. The library staff will also stay informed of any technology grants that could assist in obtaining new equipment and software.

TECHNICAL SUPPORT/MAINTENANCE

Connecting Point in Columbus is very proficient in all aspects of computer technology; and is very helpful to us when we have problems with hardware, software, networking or Internet issues. We are also able to call Windstream when we have Internet problems.

EVALUATION

The library will review this Technology Plan on an annual basis to see if goals are being met or need to be revised. Internet and computer use are tracked on a daily basis for statistical reporting and to ensure the library is meeting community needs. Attention is paid to requests and suggestions heard from the public to determine how to best serve public's needs.
