**Russian Apple Cake (Sharlotka)
Hella's Version**

4-5 tart apples, peeled, cored and cut into chunks
2 tsp. cinnamon
Sprinkle of lemon juice
5 eggs
1 cup sugar
1/2 tsp. salt
1 1/2 cups flour
1 tsp. baking powder
1 tsp. baking soda
1 tsp. vanilla

Beat the eggs and sugar together
Add flower, salt, baking powder and baking soda
Mix altogether and add vanilla flavoring
Arrange prepared apples in 9x13 baking pan which
has been slightly greased. Sprinkle with cinnamon
and lemon juice.

Pour batter over apples and bake in 350 degrees
oven for about 40 min. Cake should be slightly
browned. Tooth pick inserted near center should
come out clean. Dust with powdered sugar . I
sprinkled with more powdered sugar when cooled.
May serve with whipped topping.

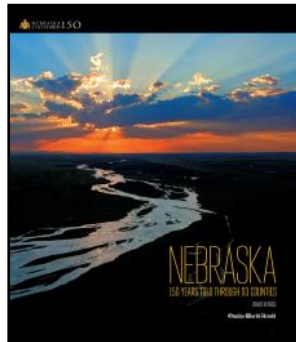

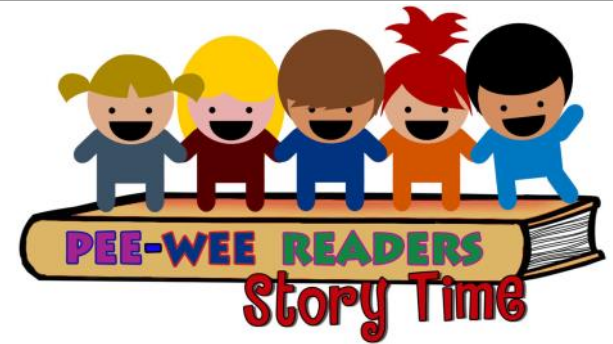
Nebraska: 100 years told through 93 Counties
