



Summer Reading Activities at The Tilden Public Library

To help promote the National Summer Reading program theme, Build a Better World, the Raymond A. Whitwer Tilden Public Library will be offering a variety of activities in July for kids of all ages.

Beginning Saturday, July 1st and throughout the month of July, kids ages **12 and under** can participate in *Book Bingo* by picking up a bingo card at the library and completing the tasks on the cards. Prizes will be awarded for completion of the cards returned to the library. Kids do not need to be a library member to participate.

On Saturday, July 15 from 10:30 am – 12 noon in the Lied Auditorium, the library will offer *Let's Build Together* for kids **2 – 5 years old**. This one day program will include story time along with coloring and building activities. Children must be accompanied by an adult, childcare provider or older sibling. No pre-registration is necessary to participate.

6 year olds up to high school age kids will have the **week of July 17 – 20** to be creative and use their imaginations for their project *Build Your Own Story*. By using a large variety of materials on hand, the kids will be able to create collage vision and story boards that tells something about themselves such as their past; future goals; their favorite (anything); vacations or travels; families and more. The possibilities are endless. No pre-registration is necessary, however kids participating should meet the first day on **Monday July 17 at 10:00 am** in the Lied Auditorium to get their seats, basic materials to start, and instructions, after which kids will be able to come & go throughout the week during library hours to work on and complete their projects. During the week kids 8 and under will need to be supervised by an adult, childcare provider or older sibling

To finalize the program, kids and adults who participated in any of the Summer Reading activities are invited to a *Build Your Own Ice Cream Sundae* party on **Friday July 21 at 2:00 pm**. Also on display will be the vision and story boards that were created during the week.
