Grilled Pork Tenderloin

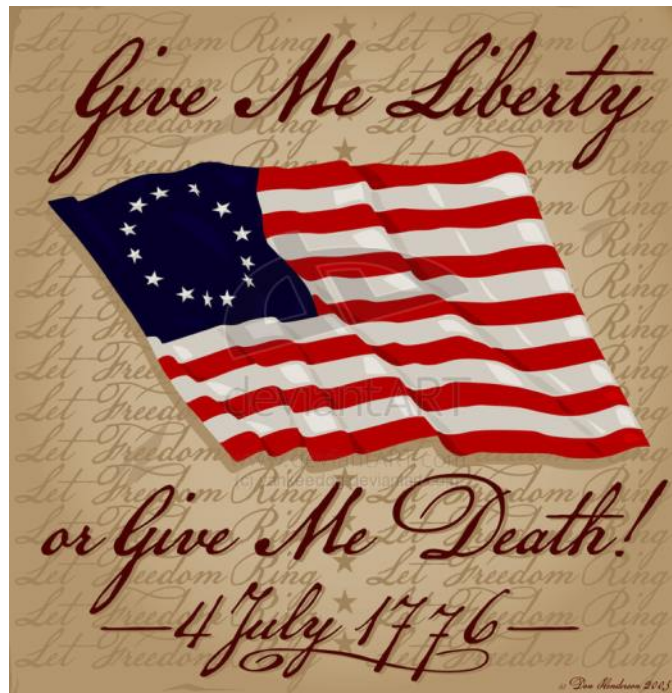
Ingredients:

2 (1 pound) pork tenderloins
1 teaspoon garlic powder
1 teaspoon salt
1 teaspoon ground black pepper
1 cup barbeque sauce

Directions:

Prepare grill for indirect heat.
Rub tenderloins with pepper, salt and garlic powder
Lightly oil grate
Place tenderloin on grate, and position drip pan under meat.
Cook over indirect heat for 30 minutes.
Brush tenderloins with barbeque sauce. Continue cooking for 15 minutes, or to desired tenderness.
Slice pork, and serve.

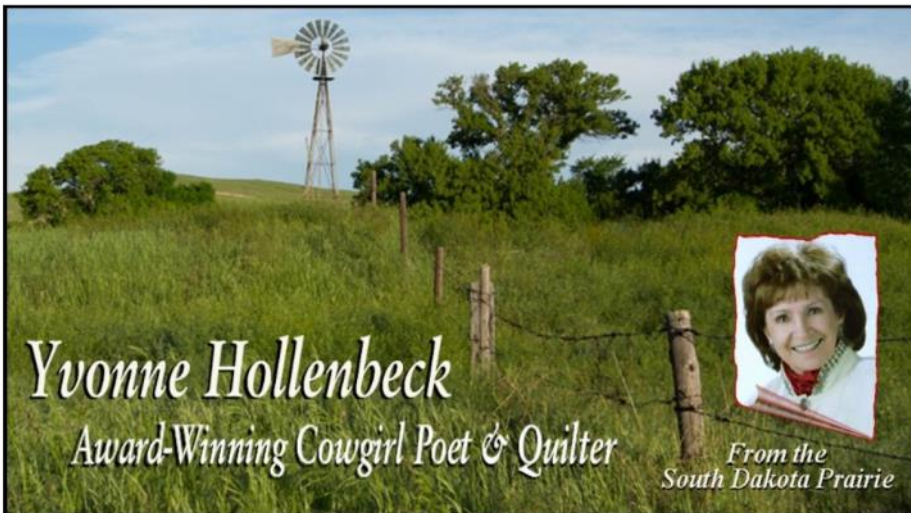
