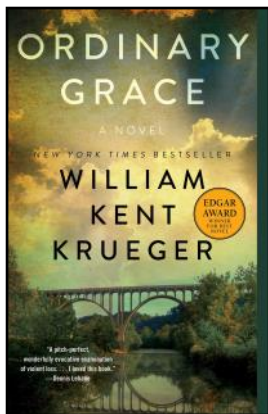


Fireside Chat Book Discussion

Carrot Cake

Cake Ingredients:

2 cups sugar
1 cup cooking oil
4 eggs
2 cups flour
1/2tsp.salt
1 tsp baking powder
1 tsp baking soda
1 tsp cinnamon
2 cups grated carrots

Frosting Ingredients:

1/2 cup butter, softened
1 8oz package cream cheese
1 pound powdered sugar
2 tsps. Vanilla
1 cup pecans, chopped fine

Instructions:

Mix together sugar, oil and eggs. Sift flour with salt, baking powder, baking soda and cinnamon and add to first mixture. Then add carrots and mix well.

Pour into 9x13 pan in a 350 degrees oven and bake until testing needle comes out clean.

Frosting: Cream butter and cream cheese together and add powdered sugar and vanilla. Then add nuts and spread on cooled cake. *Bon Appetit!*



Celebrating Memorial Day 2019

Memorial Day, formally known as Decoration Day, is a federal holiday observed yearly on the last Monday of May. It is a day that commemorated all men and women who have died while serving in the military for the United States of America.

Memorial Day dates back to the American Civil War. It started to honor soldiers who had died during that war. The original national celebration of Decoration Day was held on May 30, 1868. In the late 19th century the day was expanded to include the deceased veterans of all wars fought by American forces. Many will wear or put on a display of red poppies as a symbol of fallen soldiers. This tradition grew out of the famous poem "In Flander's Field" in honor of all those who died serving the nation during war.
