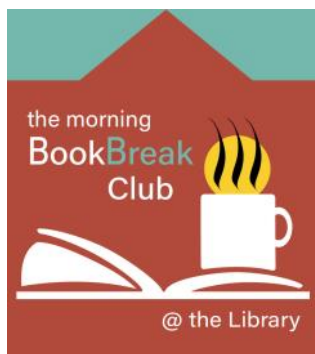

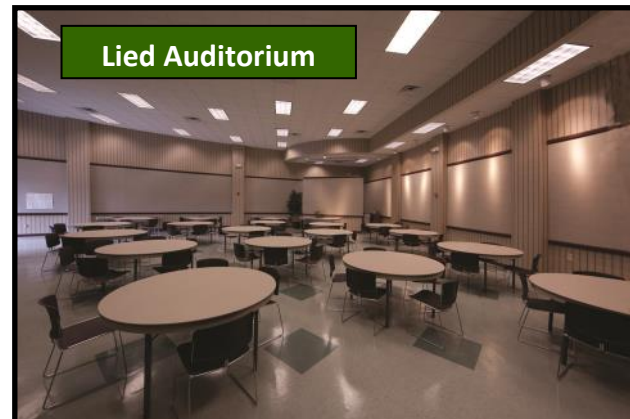
## Borrow eBooks & audiobooks free from our library
