- ✓ Community Programming (convenient, low-cost, quality!)—Daycare Book Swaps2x/mo, READ-at-the-POOLs, Story Hours, LEGO Clubs, Saturday Workshops for Kids, Painting Parties, Art Shows (collaboration w/ school), Verdigre Vanoce, Crochet-with-Connie, Preschool visits) [PLEASE TAKE A BROCHURE FOR UPCOMING PROGRAMS IN FEB-APR!]
- ✓ MANY donations from community--books, audios, dvds, furnishings, \$, toys for in-library use
- ✓ WiFi router replaced & internet speed increased again
- ✓ New website-- *libraries.ne.gov/Verdigre*; modest increase in use of social media
- ✓ Volunteers welcomed (e.g. Library Board & Foundation, SRP teen helpers/guest presenters, a weekly volunteer)
- ✓ Upcoming summer events for kids: LEGO Guy—June 10, Jim Cosgrove (Mr. Stinky Feet) concert—June 22 (*collaboration w/ girls softball*), Illustration Workshop by Bruce Arant—July 15 ... and Summer Rdg Program offerings similar to last year
- ✓ KH received \$250 grant to attend State Library Conference (Oct. 2016)
- ✓ Youth Internship Grant approved! (2 h.s. or college hires for summer 2017)

Challenges

- ✓ Technology updates needed (all public computers 6 years old; *Library Board making Technology Plan & Lib. Foundation willing to help with funding*)
- ✓ Circulation Software (ours is obsolete, runs on Windows XP; will change to Apollo/Biblionix in spring—catalog will be online—annual subscription fee \$800 needs to be budgeted)
- ✓ Up for re-accreditation in 2017 (KH expects us to rate higher than bronze level)
- ✓ Inaccuracies in Financial Records (from previous Village Clerk) still plague us (*improving*)
- ✓ Need improved lighting for south aisle in library (*reminder from M. Forejt*)
