I attended a council meeting asking to attend the Summer Reading Program workshop in Lincoln, Nov. 4<sup>th</sup> and that I receive mileage. This was approved.

Attendance for preschool summer reading was low. It was held July 29<sup>th</sup> and Aug. 5<sup>th</sup>.

We had a large amount of LEGOs donated this summer. The LEGO program will start again in Jan.

The Library Foundation is purchasing a new microfilm machine, computer and copier for the Heritage room, and outside lighting at the 3 entrances. They will also have the dying maple tree removed this fall or winter. Carol Hughes will be donating a tree and the planting of the tree this spring.

Blue Springs City Council is once again giving a donation of \$750.00 to the Library, to be used for large print books and other material needed for the sight impaired.
