1. The **Elmer Baker** display case is filled with a display of from York Adopt-A-Pet with photos of animals hoping for new homes during the holiday season. The **Kent Bedient** gallery is host to a display by the Living Water Mission.
2. The **Annual Avenue of Trees** display is open and being enjoyed by all who come to the library. There are 15 trees of various sizes and one six-foot nutcracker to enjoy.
3. Fall story time ends in December this popular program continues to be well attended. Youth Services librarian, **Judy Andrews** hosts approximately 30 children and their caregivers every Friday morning.
4. The *Success* class from York Public Schools comes to the library twice a month to check out books and listen to a book read to them by Youth Services Librarian, **Judy Andrews**. This activity includes 46 students and 24 adults.
5. Our IT Specialist, **Greg Buller** has completed process of replacing our two CRT TVs on carts and one portable LCD projector with ceiling mounted devices in each of our meeting rooms.
6. **Deb Robertson** attended a *Summer Reading Workshop* hosted by the Southeast Library System office where a session from the UNL Extension youth 4-H program agents sharing how they have correlated their 4-H curriculum to the summer reading theme for libraries and are now looking for partnerships with libraries to promote this new service to children.
7. **Greg** and **Deb** attended the 2016 eRate training at the Nebraska Library Commission. Greg will be working through the application process for the library this year.
8. **Rachel Mayfield**, our technical services support staff member continues to work to earn public library certification with the next course on communication scheduled in January.
9. The Friends of the Library are appreciative of the City Council's support of our Valentine's Day fund raiser by approving our request for a special designated site to serve alcohol. Tom Mason has reported that he has received notice that the State has approved our request also. This event is planned for the evening of February 13, 2016.
