1. The Elmer Baker display case and the Kent Bedient Gallery are filled for the summer with items on the Summer Reading Club theme of "Libraries Rock!"
2. StoryWalk 2018 books are selected and being prepared to be delivered on the trail each month through the year. The July book is *Henry's Map* by David Elliot.
3. The Summer Reading Club activities for children are set to close on Friday, July 20 with an outdoor concert with Rockin' Red. The children have enjoyed a Humanities Nebraska program with David Seay sharing Traditional Folk Music, movies, and 4-H classes exploring Acoustics, Sound Waves, and others sounds. There have also been brown bag story times and afternoons of gaming at the library through June and July.
4. Summer Reading Club for our adult readers has 105 participants exploring the myriad of services provided by the library through bingo cards.
5. Library policy review by staff is continues.
6. Collection development and stack maintenance continues. This work is accomplished by all staff as time allows.
7. We have two part-time staff leaving us this summer. We are interviewing for these openings now with an anticipated start date in August.
