1. The Elmer Baker display case and the Kent Bedient Gallery will soon be filled with items on the Summer Reading Club theme of "Libraries Rock!"
2. StoryWalk 2018 books are selected and being prepared to be delivered on the trail each month through the year. The May book is *Who Hops?* by Katie Davis
3. Library policy review by staff is scheduled once each week for the rest of the year. Because most library policies have not been reviewed in more than a decade this is a major project.
4. Collection development and stack maintenance continues. This work is accomplished by all staff as time allows.
5. Storytime and Toddler Dance and Fun Time end in April. Attendance in both of these activities continues to grow.
6. Planning summer reading programs for all ages are consuming any extra time the staff have when not meeting the needs of the patrons who come in or call our library.
7. The annual survey data we are required to submit to the Nebraska Library Commission as part of our accreditation process has been completed. A summary of this report is attached in a separate file. If you are interested in seeing the full report let me know.
8. We have two part-time staff leaving us this summer. We will be advertising these openings in June with an anticipated start date in August.
