1. Kilgore Memorial Library is hosting a poster series from the Smithsonian Traveling Exhibition Service. *Votes for Women A Portrait of Persistence* is the title of the exhibit. The posters are displayed in the Bedient Gallery through October. The Baker Display case is filled with teddy bears from library staff personal collections. There is a sign in the case telling patrons how un**bear**able it was at the library without them.
2. We continue to limit seating in the library to encourage social distancing during the new phase set by Governor Ricketts on November 11.
3. Carside pickup requests are rising again. This service allows patrons to request items they would like to checkout and when they arrive at the library they call to let us know then we deliver the requested items to them in a crate left on the curb for the patron to pick up.
4. Our Education Outreach Coordinator, Carol Baker and her husband John, are recording storytime live at 10:30 am on Tuesdays in the children's area of the building. We rope off the area and invite families who prefer to come to the library and watch storytime to join us in a special socially distanced seating area.
5. Library staff are working on a redesign of the library's website. We hope to introduce the new look after the first of the year.
6. Collection development continues in the DVD, Juvenile Fiction and Adult Non-Fiction areas of the library.
