The regular Board Meeting of the Village of Arlington Public Library Board, Nebraska, was held at the Arlington Public Library on February 10th, 2026. Board President Bracht called the meeting to order at 9:35 a.m. Roll call was taken as follows: Sheila Bracht, present; Kelsea Wolfe, present; Sally Hagemeister, present; Hannah Coufal, present; Elizabeth Kennemer, absent. Notice of the meeting was given in advance by posting at the Arlington Public Library, the Arlington Post Office, and the Village Office. Board President noted the posting of the Open Meetings Act as available at the Arlington Public Library. A vote of 4-0 approved the January meeting minutes.
