

Tin Can Cow Bell

Supplies Needed:

- Tin Can
- Cow print Template
- Wooded beads
- String

Directions:

Poke a hole in the bottom of the decorated can with a hammer and nail. Then cut a length of yarn about three feet long. Fold it in half then tie on a couple of beads. Tie two big knots a couple inches above the beads (to keep the string from pulling through), then thread the end above the knot through the hole on the tin can to create the clapper for your bell. You may need to use the nail to help you fish the yarn through the hole. Tie off the ends so the yarn won't slide back through. Now the bell is ready to ring!
