

Homemade Cat Treats

Want to know what's actually going into your furry friend's snacks? Try whipping up a batch of these easy, homemade cat treats. If you're unable to make your treats small enough for an easy bit, simply make them as small as you can and break each treat up before giving it to your cat.

Active: 10 mins**Total:** 25 mins**Yield:** Makes 80 treats

Ingredients

1 (4-oz.) can tuna in spring water, well-drained and flaked

1 cup all-purpose flour

1 tablespoon dried catnip

1 large egg

Directions

Step 1

Preheat oven to 350°F. Process all ingredients in a food processor until a smooth, thick dough forms.

Step 2

Form dough into 80 (1/4-teaspoon-size) balls. Place on a baking sheet lined with parchment paper, and slightly flatten each ball.

Step 3

Bake in preheated oven until golden and crisp, about 15 minutes. Cool completely. Store in air-tight container up to 5 days, or freeze.
