- The summer interns distributed bookmarks with the library hours and suckers to the elementary students at Jackson and Ponca schools.

- Two upcoming events are scheduled: October 5, Humanities Nebraska presentation at PSP; November 2, One Book One Nebraska book discussion.
- Friends is searching for person to fill the office of the treasurer.
- Friends is sponsoring a community cleaning of the library gardens on Saturday, August 19, 8:00-10:00 a.m.

- Possible fund-raising events for new computers were discussed.
